# Mayor Barb Tolbert, 2019 State of the City.

- Economic Development -
  - Trying to bring more family waged jobs to the city.
  - o Lakewood/Smokey Point Library opened in January 2018. 41,058 visits in 2018.
  - o 72 new businesses in Arlington 934 total businesses now in Arlington.
  - o Finalist in top 10 of Small Business Revolution. May 1st seminar still on.
  - o Completion of Legion Park Stage.
  - o 2950 volunteer hours logged in Arlington last year.
  - o 523 new building permits, 21 land use permits.
  - o Formed Smokey Point Business Committee in partnership with Marysville.
  - New median design approved for 67th Ave NE attractive low maintenance.
  - Arlington Valley Road new road through manufacturing/industrial center.
  - o 1.12 miles of water main upgrades and 1.38 miles of pavement preservation
  - Added 84 single family residences/housing units to "housing stock."
  - Added 182 units of multi-family units to "housing stock."
  - o Airport buildings at 100% capacity.
- Public Safety -
  - APD Outreach Team dedicated LEO and Embedded Social Worker. 711 contact. 33 people completed long-term treatment program.
  - o Community Resource Center 3886 total visits,
  - Overall reduction in crime in 2018 compared to 2017.
  - Saw increase in DV (4%) and Fraud (3%)
  - City is adding a Domestic Violence coordinator Bridge Services to try to assist victims with staying the course.
  - o Total of 31 officers in APD now. 2 added this past year.
  - Added three new members to EMS department.
  - Hiring Shared Fire Marshal and Medical Services Coordinator (shared with North County Regional Fire.)
- Fiscal Sustainability -
  - 6th year in a row, no utility rate increase.
  - o Ballfield Fees to cover future maintenance costs.
  - Sales tax collections up 12%.

- o Debt obligations decreased by 2.7 million. Current debt obligation is .6%, well below our debt threshold for the city.
- Bond rating has increased.

Going to have a "vendor parking program" to use President's Elementary for parking. Marysville Ford is donating a van to shuttle vendors.
